PUBLIC NOTICE: REOPENING AND REGULARISATION OF MEMBERSHIP REGISTRATION

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to the order of the High Court of South Africa, Western Cape Division, Cape Town under Case No. 2025-238197 delivered on 24 March 2026 (hereinafter referred to as “The Judgment”).

The Moslem Cemetery Board hereby initiates the process for the reopening and regularisation of membership registration.

This notice is published to notify the Muslim Community of Cape Town and surrounding areas of the membership registration process.

1. Purpose of this notice

The purpose of this process is to:

- 1.1 reopen membership registration;
- 1.2 regularise the membership register of The Moslem Cemetery Board; and
- 1.3 enable the convening of a Special General Meeting for the election of a governing body, as directed by The Judgment.

2. Who may apply for membership

Muslims who qualify for membership in terms of the 1948 Constitution and in terms of The Judgment are invited to apply for inscription in the membership register.

This includes:

- 2.1 a survivor of those who originally subscribed or contributed towards the cost of acquiring the cemetery property; or
- 2.2 a lineal descendant of any such subscriber or contributor; or
- 2.3 any Muslim by reason of a demonstrated interest in the cemetery qualifies to apply for inscription in the membership register in terms of The Judgment.

3. Registration period

Applications for membership must be submitted on or before Friday, 12 June 2026 at 17H00.

Late applications may not be accepted if receipt thereof would prejudice the finalisation of the membership roll for purposes of the Special General Meeting.

Only persons duly registered as members pursuant to this process will be entitled to participate in the Special General Meeting to be convened for the election of a governing body, in accordance with The Judgment.
